PDFCrypt allow to set owner and user passwords and usage permissions on PDF files in a flow.

Connections

 $\mathbf{PDFCrypt}$ node requires one or more input connection and one output connection

Element properties

Owner password : required This is the password needed to change the access permissions. It is commonly also referred to as the master password or the permissions password.

User password: This is the password needed to open a PDF for reading. It is also known as the open doc password. If not set, no password is required to read the PDF.

Output: Set what output the element will save:

- Both original and encrypted: Original input file will be saved in output, with optional **Original** file postfix added to filename; Encrypted file will be saved, with optional **Excripted file** postfix added to filename
- Only encrypted: Encrypted file will be saved in output. Original file will be discarded.

Excripted file postfix: String added to output filename. Only valid when **Output** is *Both original and encrypted*

Original file postfix: String added to original file when moved to output. Only valid when Output is $Both\ original\ and\ encrypted$

At least one between Excripted file postfix and Original file postfix must be set when Output is Both original and encrypted.

Set custom permissions: Set to *Yes* to set custom user permissions. Any permissions set to input PDF will be overwritten.

Custom permissions:

Can fill forms: User can fill existing interactive form fields, including signature fields

Can print: User can print the document, possibly not at the highest quality level, depending on whether 'Can print hi-quality' is also set

Can print hi-quality: User can print the document to a representation from which a faithful digital copy of the PDF content could be generated, When this permission is not set, printing is limited to a low-lebel representation of the appearance, possibly degraded quality.

Can extract content for accessibility: User can extract text and graphics in support of accessibility

Can copy content: User can copy or otherwise extract text and graphics from the document by operation other than for accessibility support

Can add or modiy annotations: User can add or modify text annotation, fill interactive form fields and, if Can edit document is set, create or modify interactive form fields, including signature fields.

Can edit pages and bookmars: User can insert, rotate or delete pages and create bookmarks or thumbnail images, even if Can edit document is not set

Can edit document: User can modify the contents of the document by operations other than those contolled by Can add or modiy annotations, Can fill forms and Can edit pages and bookmars
