

Split XLS(X)

Description

This app allows you to split an incoming xlsx or xls file into multiple new files based on the number of rows you specify. Each resulting file will contain the defined number of rows from the original spreadsheet.

For example, if you set the value to 1, each row of the original xls(x) file will be saved as a separate file.

Compatibility

Switch 2023 Fall and later.

Connections

The app has one incoming connection and one outgoing connection. In case of an error (e.g., invalid file format or unreadable content), the job fails.

Properties detailed info

The app provides a single configurable property that determines how many rows should be included in each resulting file.

Flow elements properties

• Lines per file:

Specifies the number of rows to include in each split xls(x) file. Must be a positive number.

Example:

- \circ 1 \rightarrow Each row becomes a separate xls(x) file
- \circ 10 \rightarrow Each file contains 10 rows
