

Release Note for BoardingPass 21.0

What's New:

1. **Ignore inner edge for bleed check:** With this release, the user has the option to ignore inner edge for bleed check so it does not show bleed errors for the same. This is a useful feature if your document is a book, magazine or brochure, amongst others.
2. **WeTransfer Multiple files support:** Until now BoardingPass only had support for WeTransfer mails with only single file. Now it's possible to have multiple attachments in WeTransfer mails and BoardingPass will be able to open all the PDF attachments shared via WeTransfer mail.
3. **Software Analytics Opt out Support:** Users having a subscription license have the option to opt out from softwareanalytics now.
4. **Bleed check string optimization :** We have updated preferences and error strings for bleed check feature so they are more clear and easier to understand.

Customer Bug Resolved:

1. ENFC -12756 : The color space warning gives wrong warnings saying that objects are ICC-based CMYK when they are really DeviceCMYK

Known issues:

1. ENFC-12525 : The objects gets highlighted in wrong area for rotated PDFs
2. ENFC -12756 : Secured files are not supported in BoardingPass
3. ENFC -10429 : BoardingPass doesn't respond in some scenarios
4. ENFC -12862 : Check color action (gray color) does not report the grayscale image as error

5. ENFC -11982 : With the **New Outlook** preview feature, drag and drop of email does not work.
