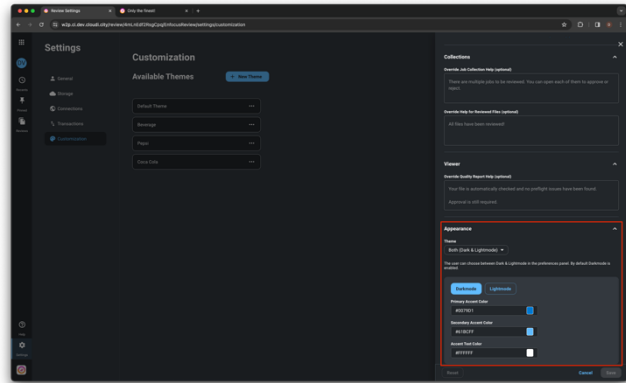


Admin

Customization, and creation of themes

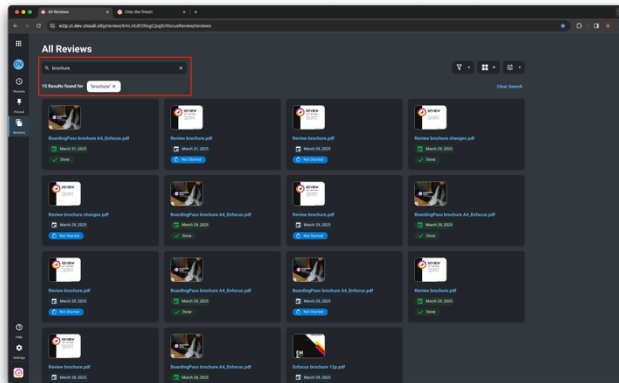
In the 2349 release, we unveiled an exciting feature that empowers users to craft personalized themes, allowing them to tailor the viewer and collections environment with unique logos, company details, and post-approval preferences.

In our ongoing pursuit of improvement, this release will unveil an added layer of customization. Users can now effortlessly tailor the color scheme of their chosen theme, empowering them with enhanced flexibility to craft their desired visual experience. Moreover, users can specify whether a theme is accessible in Light mode, Dark mode, or both, further enriching their customization options.



Search bar

In the administrative interface, a new feature has been introduced, allowing users to search for a specific review. This newly added search bar allows users to search by file name or partial file name.

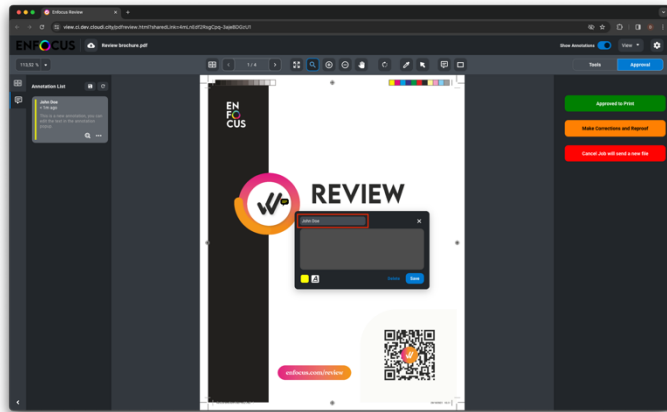




Viewer

In the viewer interface, users can now specify the name of the individual creating an annotation.



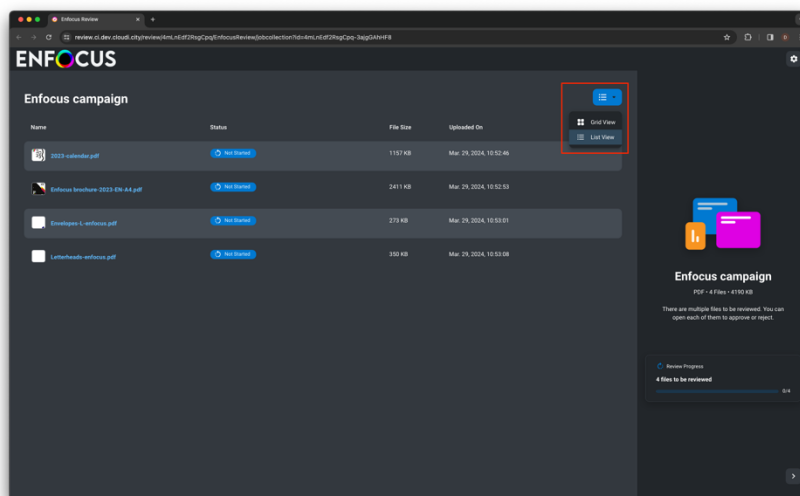
Improvement

We've added a new feature to the Switch Review app called "Performance Tuning." Now, you can easily set the maximum number of tasks the app can handle simultaneously for smoother performance.

Improvement

- In the previous version of the app, the deletion date was visualized in the admin section of Review, this has been changed to visualize the due date instead.
- When uploading a folder to a collection the automatic creation of the thumbnails where not triggered in Review, this has now been resolved.
